You might like to speak to one of the wardens or our treasurers at church about this safe and very easy way to have your offerings go straight from your account to ours. Rev. Tracey notes: It saves paper, plus envelopes AND eliminates the frustration of forgetting our cheques or envelopes at home on a Sunday...which we've all experienced from time to time.

And If you are not comfortable with using pre-authorized giving there is another option. You might like to give post-dated cheques which we can safely store and use accordingly.
